Last month RIPTA was proud to be part of Grow Smart RI's forum: "Next Stop: Making Transit Work for RI." The forum, held at the RI Convention Center in Providence, was attended by nearly 200

people. The forum's speakers included Governor Gina Raimondo and transit industry experts – including RIPTA personnel. One of the strong messages from the event was that Rhode Island already has the transit planning talent and development patterns to further its work to help more people reach as many destinations as possible – as quickly as possible – via public transportation.

The keynote speaker was Jarrett Walker, an international consultant in public transit design and policy and author of both the popular public transit blog, *HumanTransit.org*, and the book, *Human Transit: How Clearer Thinking about Public Transit Can Enrich Our Communities and Our Lives*. Mr. Walker took the time to single out Amy Pettine, RIPTA's Executive Director of Planning, for her expertise and transit vision.
