The final numbers are in, and we are happy to announce that this year, we raised a total of 8,391 pounds of food for the Rhode Island Community Food Bank ! **THANK YOU** for making the 6TH Annual Stuff A Bus a huge success!



We would also like to thank our community partners – Ocean State Job Lot and iHeartRadio – for all the hard work they put into the food drive. And thanks to Job Lot's commitment to fighting hunger, the food drive was able to contribute more to the Food Bank. Cash donations were collected at Job Lot stores and Job Lot also contributed three tractor trailer trucks loaded with non-perishable food items.

The Rhode Island Community Food Bank distributes food to people in need through a statewide network of 160 member agencies. These agencies include food pantries, meal sites, shelters, youth programs and senior centers. Each month, 57,000 struggling Rhode Islanders receive food assistance at these agencies.

RIPTA will detour Routes 1, 3, 6, 17, 19, 20, 22, 27, 28, 30, 31, 33, 34, 35, 60, 66, 78, 92 and the R-Line in to accommodate the Downtown Jingle 5K Road Race. All RIPTA bus lines are to expect minor delays around Kennedy Plaza during this time.

RIPTA TO RUN HOLIDAY SERVICE SCHEDULE ON MONDAY, DECEMBER 25, 2017 AND MONDAY, JANUARY 1, 2018

RIPTA will operate all regular fixed-route bus service on a Sunday/Holiday schedule on Monday, December 25, 2017 in observance of Christmas Day and Monday, January 1, 2018 in observance of New Year's Day. RIPTA offices, including the Photo Identification and Ticket Sales Offices in Kennedy Plaza, will not be staffed on Christmas Day or New Year's Day. Also, the Flex Service reservation line (1-877-906-FLEX) and the RIde reservation line (461-9760) will not be staffed on either holiday.
