## RIPTA TO RUN HOLIDAY SERVICE SCHEDULE ON WEDNESDAY, DECEMBER 25, 2019 AND WEDNESDAY, JANUARY 1, 2020

RIPTA will operate all regular fixed route bus service on a Sunday/Holiday schedule on Wednesday, December 25, 2019 in observance of Christmas Day and Wednesday, January 1, 2020 in observance of New Year's Day. RIPTA offices, including the Photo Identification and Ticket Sales Offices in Kennedy Plaza, will not be staffed on Christmas Day or New Year's Day. Also, the Flex Service reservation line (1-877-906-FLEX) and the RIde reservation line (461-9760) will not be staffed on either holiday.
