BUS STOP REALIGNMENT PROJECT UPDATE

The Bus Stop Realignment Project, which will consolidate bus stops statewide, is currently in Phase 6 of implementation. 236 bus stops were removed during the first 5 phases.

The intent of this project is to improve passenger experience and route efficiency through more consistent spacing of stops. The removal and realignment of many stops system wide will allow RIPTA to reduce bus stop redundancy, operate more efficiently, reduce conflicts with neighboring properties and parking,

and focus investment on the remaining bus stops. This means faster bus service for you and savings for us! For more detailed information, including an implementation schedule, visit ripta.com/stops.
