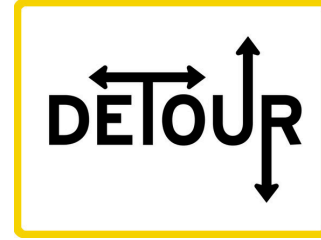




DETOURS

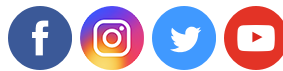
