MOVING TRANSIT FORWARD IN WEST BAY, PAWTUCKET AND NEWPORT

RIPTA has plans to improve bus service in West Bay, Pawtucket and Newport and we want to know what you think! We are proposing the addition of three new routes as well as service improvements to Routes 1, 13, 29, 71, 73, 75, 76, 78, 80 and the R-Line. RIPTA encourages passengers to view the proposed changes online and submit their feedback at a community-focused virtual workshop.

"Where is this bus going?" is a common question passengers ask themselves as they are approaching a bus. The sign above the windshield – known as the destination sign – displays the bus route letter/number, the name of the route, and the destination of the bus.

PAWTUCKET/CENTRAL FALLS TRANSIT CENTER UPDATE

RIPTA's team met with the Rhode Island Department of Transportation (RIDOT) last week to check on the progress of the new Pawtucket/Central Falls Transit Center. The Pawtucket/Central Falls Transit Center, featuring commuter rail and bus connections, is currently under construction on Pine Street in Pawtucket.

Although it may be hard to envision, the photo here depicts where buses will turn in, loop around and then drop passengers off at their stop. The ramp leading up to the rail boarding area has been installed and the awning, which will protect passengers from the elements, is currently being fabricated.
