Did you know that more than 18 million trips were taken on public transportation in Rhode Island last year? The majority of those were bus trips with RIPTA (about 16.1 million trips), but the overall number also includes commuter rail, ferry and Amtrak. That statistic is just one of dozens of interesting facts that you

can find in the recently-released "State of the System" report. The report is an important milestone as RIPTA works with partner state agencies to create the first Transit Master Plan for Rhode Island's future. Kennedy Plaza will be closed all day and night for the event. All bus stops in Kennedy Plaza will be temporarily relocated to Empire Street during this time.
