The economic growth potential for all of East Bay was the topic of discussion at a special forum held recently in Warren, with RIPTA participating. Our CEO, Scott Avedisian, took the opportunity to talk about the importance of



public transportation to economic development and to highlight some new business-friendly routes we have launched.

Those routes include the new spur of Route 61X that gets employees from Providence to Warren area businesses, our Qx express service from Pawtucket and Providence to the Quonset Business Park, and our new Route 24x which connects Providence and Newport with a stop in Fall River.

The event also featured Congressman David Cicilline and Scott Jensen, Director of RI Department of Labor and Training.
